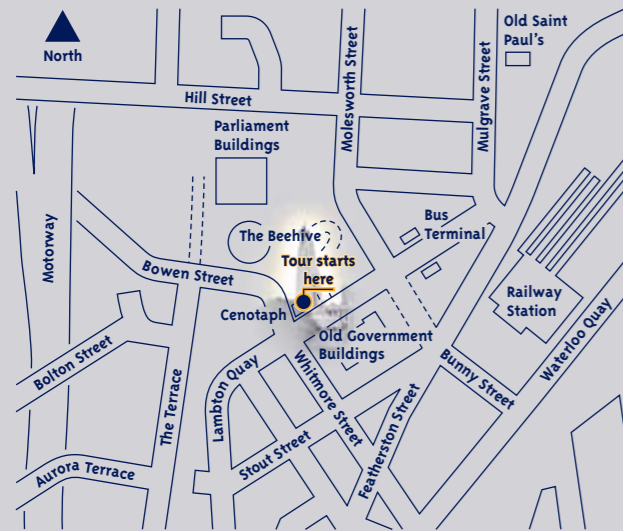

### 1. WELLINGTON - THE DARK SIDE

The original walking tour of Wellington's historical underbelly – murder scenes, riots, dens of ill-repute and more...

- The crimes of New Zealand's longest-serving prisoner.
- The massive brawl involving US and New Zealand servicemen that left Manners and Cuba Streets swimming in blood and broken glass.

The story of drinking in Wellington – includes visits to two historical pubs.

- Tour traces the evolution of the Kiwi drinking culture – from frontier grog shops to the prohibitionists and 'wowsers', to the infamous 'six o'clock swill'.
- Hear Wellington's quirky history (amidst the drinking yarns) and visit some of its notable landmarks – including the grounds of Parliament.
- Pub stops include complimentary drinks.
